The Vista Development comprises the delivery of approximately 452 units over two buildings, Block C at the North of the Site and Block L at the South, along with ground floor retail and associated car parking.

Progress on the basement slab in Block L is ongoing

- As work progresses, a substantial amount of concrete pours will be taking place over the next few months for the concrete floor slabs in Block C and Block L.
- As we progress up each level, can we politely remind those of you overlooking the site to be mindful of your privacy as the new buildings get higher.
- Wandsworth have agreed that some vehicles can unload from Sopwith Way (South Side).
- The South entrance (Gate 2) is now in operation and a parking restriction is currently in place.
- Ground works on Block L has commenced, and we expect muck-away activities to continue. This activity will be well co-ordinated to prevent any traffic disturbance.
- Sopwith Way road (the section from the river to the round-about alongside the railway line) will have the tarmac completed, 5 extra street lights and drainage installed and a new section of pavement built outside the Hotel. These works which are required by Wandsworth Council will hopefully commence by mid/end- June 2015. in order to complete the works as quick as possible working hours will be 8am to 6pm.
- There are still a number of cabins that need to installed under the viaduct. Due to the vehicles being wide loads that cannot travel through central London during the day, these works may have to take place out of hours and at the weekend. Approval from Wandsworth will be obtained before works take place and this will be managed by Berkeley Homes
